2. Sophie buys 3 packs of pens. Each pack contains 12 pens and costs £4. How many pens does she buy, and how much does she spend?
3. A charity walk is 18 km long. Jack completes the walk on Saturday and then walks another 12 km on Sunday. If he walked 8 km before lunch on Sunday, how many kilometres did he walk after lunch?
4. A school orders 25 boxes of exercise books. Each box contains 40 books. If 175 books are given out, how many remain?
5. A train leaves at 09:45 and arrives at 12:20. It is delayed by 25 minutes. How long was the journey including the delay?
6. Emily saves £18 each week for 6 weeks. She then spends £35 on a new game. How much money does she have left?
7. A baker makes 240 cookies. He packs them equally into bags of 12. He sells 15 bags. How many cookies remain?
8. A swimming pool is 25 metres long. Lucy swims 32 lengths. She then swims another 200 metres. How far has she swum altogether?
9. A shop reduces the price of a £120 bicycle by £25. A customer then uses a £10 voucher. What is the final price?
10. A football team wins 14 matches and draws 5 matches. A win earns 3 points and a draw earns 1 point. How many points do they earn altogether?

15. A school trip costs £24 per student. If 36 students go and the school contributes £150 towards the cost, how much still needs to be paid?
16. A library has 1,250 books. It buys 185 more books and then removes 97 damaged books. How many books does the library have now?
17. A concert hall sells 420 tickets at £12 each. It then spends £1,150 on running costs. How much profit does it make?
18. A cyclist rides 24 km on Monday, 31 km on Tuesday, and 27 km on Wednesday. If the cyclist's goal was 100 km, how many more kilometres are needed?
19. A warehouse stores 1,800 boxes. It sends out 475 boxes and later receives 320 new boxes. How many boxes are in the warehouse now?
20. A fundraiser raises £675 on Friday and £890 on Saturday. They spend £245 on expenses and then donate £500 to charity. How much money remains?
