



Tom reads a book every day for 8 weeks. Mia reads 5 books each week for 10 weeks. How many more books does Tom read than Mia?

Method

First, work out how many things the first person does altogether.

Remember there are 7 days in one week. If they do something every day, multiply the number of weeks by 7. Sometimes, a question may say they do something every school day, this means Monday - Friday only.

Then work out the second person's total by multiplying how many times they do it each week by the number of weeks.

Finally, subtract the smaller number from the bigger number to find how many more.

Example: Ben eats an apple every day for 10 weeks.

$$10 \times 7 = 70 \text{ apples}$$

Amy eats 6 apples each week for 11 weeks.

$$6 \times 11 = 66 \text{ apples}$$

$$70 - 66 = 4 \text{ apples}$$

So Ben eats 4 more apples than Amy.



Sam eats an apple every day for 6 weeks. Ava eats 4 apples each week for 9 weeks. How many more apples does Sam eat than Ava?

Leo practises his spelling every day for 5 weeks. Ruby practises her spelling 3 times each week for 10 weeks. How many more times does Leo practise than Ruby?

Jack feeds his fish every day for 9 weeks. Ella feeds her fish 6 times each week for 10 weeks. How many more times does Jack feed his fish than Ella?



Noah does a maths puzzle every day for 7 weeks. Lily does 4 maths puzzles each week for 11 weeks. How many more puzzles does Noah do than Lily?

Ben rides his bike every day for 6 weeks. Eva rides her bike 5 times each week for 8 weeks. How many more times does Ben ride his bike than Eva?

Amir reads a page of his comic every day for 10 weeks. Grace reads 6 pages each week for 11 weeks. How many more pages does Amir read than Grace?



Sophie practises the piano every day for 8 weeks. Harry practises the piano 5 times each week for 10 weeks. How many more times does Sophie practise than Harry?

Oscar eats a piece of fruit every day for 5 weeks. Isla eats a piece of fruit 3 times each week for 9 weeks. How many more pieces of fruit does Oscar eat than Isla?

Freddie walks his dog every day for 9 weeks. Maya walks her dog 5 times each week for 12 weeks. How many more times does Freddie walk his dog than Maya?

Answers: 6, 6, 5, 3, 5, 2, 4, 6, 8, 3
